OTHER RELEVANT INFORMATION

Martin is an unaccompanied young person who is asylum seeking. He does not yet know who his solicitor is and has not yet had his Asylum interview. He is not known to the Refugee Council Children's Panel.

Martin has been in the UK since 23/8/2015 when he arrived at port after 8 months travelling to reach the UK. He has been in the same placement since this time. The journey from Eritrea was traumatic – Martin witnessed people dying on the way. He spent 2 months locked up in a house and had to sleep sitting up as the place was so full. He has no ongoing pressure being exerted by outside and does not appear to be the victim of trafficking for gain.

Martin was in regular education from 4 years of age. He attended school from 6am – 12 noon each day. He had not yet sat any certificated exams. Martin is now attending a Year 10 class at mainstream school and enjoying this and making friends. He is getting EAL support.

PHYSICAL HEALTH ISSUES:

(a) Past issues

Martin had lost weight on his journey which included 2 weeks with no food but he has regained 5kg since arrival in the UK. He has no serious past health issues and never had to see a doctor. There is no known significant family health history though Martin thinks his mother has diabetes. He is the third oldest of 6 children – there is a new baby in the family.

(b) Newly identified issues

No ongoing health issues. Martin is not on any medication and has no known allergies.

MENTAL HEALTH ISSUES:

MOODS AND FEELINGS QUESTIONNAIRE (MFQ) SCORE = 1 / 26

Martin is experiencing the loss of family and country. However he appears to have a positive outlook and presents as resilient. He describes occasional distressing memories but these are not impacting on day to day life. He is not getting any post traumatic symptoms though was getting "hot hands" all the time – this has improved.

LIFESTYLE ISSUES:

No use of recreational drugs, alcohol nor tobacco. Martin is involved in regular sport playing football everyday. Martin has a good relationship with his carer and family. He does not have a girlfriend and is not sexually active. Martin can cook well. He is managing his pocket money. He is able to undertake his own personal care.
